

# WHAT SHOULD THEY DO?

Read through these scenarios then answer the questions below

**CALLUM IS IN THE PARK WITH HIS FRIENDS. ONE OF THEM PRODUCES A LARGE BOTTLE OF VODKA. CALLUM HAS NEVER GOT DRUNK BEFORE AND ISN'T SURE HE WANTS TO.**

- Make an excuse and go home.
- Have one sip but tell them he doesn't want any more.
- Tell his friends he doesn't want to get drunk and that they shouldn't either.
- Say that vodka gives him a headache and he prefers beer.

**HANNAH IS OUT WITH HER FRIENDS. SHE KNOWS THEY DRINK MORE THAN SHE WANTS TO, AND DOESN'T WANT TO TRY TO KEEP PACE WITH THEM.**

- Drink soft drinks but pretend that they've got vodka in.
- Tell her friends she doesn't want to get too drunk, and take it easy.
- Try to keep up with them anyway.
- Have a few drinks then go home early.

**JAMIE IS HAVING A PARTY FOR HIS BIRTHDAY, BUT HIS PARENTS HAVE SAID THEY CAN'T HAVE ANY ALCOHOL.**

- Cancel the party.
- Get some DVDs and games for the X-Box so there's plenty of other stuff to do.
- Hide some alcopops in lemonade bottles.
- Try to change his parents' mind.

**JAMEELA'S BOYFRIEND WANTS TO SLEEP WITH HER, BUT SHE'S NOT SURE SHE'S READY. HE SUGGESTS THEY HAVE SOME WINE TO HELP HER RELAX.**

- Make sure she only has one glass so she stays in control.
- Drink the wine and see how she feels.
- Get rid of her boyfriend.
- Tell her boyfriend she'll sleep with him when she wants to, not when she's drunk.

**ROB AND HIS FRIENDS ARE AT A PARTY ON THE OTHER SIDE OF TOWN AND NEED TO GET HOME. IT'S 2AM AND THEY DON'T HAVE ANY MONEY FOR A TAXI. SOMEONE THEY KNOW FROM SCHOOL OFFERS TO DRIVE THEM BACK. HE INSISTS HE'S FINE TO DRIVE, BUT ROB HAS SEEN HIM DRINKING.**

- Say nothing. It will be fine.
- Call his parents and ask them to pick him and his friends up.
- Ask the driver to drive slowly and make sure everyone wears a seat belt.
- Try to persuade his friends to walk home instead.
